<p><b>11</b> <b>historical event</b></p> <p>something that happened in the past</p> <p><i>Example:</i> The American Revolution and the Constitutional Convention are both historical events.</p> <p>(SS070103)</p> 	<p><b>12</b> <b>historical account</b></p> <p>a representation of an event from the past</p> <p><i>Example:</i> The description of the American Revolution in our history book is an historical account.</p> <p>(SS070103)</p> 
<p><b>13</b> <b>history</b></p> <p>events or accounts of events from the past</p> <p><i>Example:</i> When people study history, they study about people and events of the past.</p> <p>(SS070103)</p> 	<p><b>14</b> <b>historian</b></p> <p>an expert in or student of history</p> <p><i>Example:</i> The job of an historian is to interpret past events and interpret their causes.</p> <p>(SS070103)</p>
