

a stone wheel for sharpening; an abrasive wheel




that sharpens or polishes something

45 kilometer

a unit of length, the common measure of



1 kilometer (or 1 km) = a little more than

distances equal to 1000 meters, and equivalent to 0.621 mile

Example: The field was five kilometers wide.

either of a pair of long, slender poles upon which

Example: They built a stilt-legged house in case of a flood.
