





2. Fold your paper into eight squares.



Draw a timeline across the center with arrows on each end.



4. Divide your timeline into **B.C**.E. and **C.E.** at the **third** fold (0).




5. Mark every half inch starting at zero.



- 6. Start with zero, count back by 2,000's to 52,000 B.C.E.
- 7. Start with zero, count forward by 2,000's to 16,000 C.E.
- 8. Mark the Old Stone Age with blue (pg 44 timeline).

- 9. Mark the New Stone Age with green (pg. 52 timeline).
- 10. Mark the events on pp. 42-3. Subtract 2000 from each since it's about 2000 C.E.
- 11. Use circa (c.) on three dates. Circa means about.
- 12. Place 2016 C.E. on the timeline.
- 13. Make a 10 inch inset timeline, enlarged area, so you can see 2016 C.E. and the years before (your birth), and after (your future).



- 14. Put your birth and today on the timeline.
- 15. Put five events on the small timeline about your life. Three significant dates you plan for your future (examples: first job, graduation, significant birthday, 1st book published, 1st invention (technology!)). Two events that have happened in the past.
- 16. Put the title, "My Place in Time" at the top of your paper.
- 17. Staple the rubric on the front. Show off your talents and knowledge!
- 18.***Events should have a date, caption and color picture.
